1. INTRODUCTION

1.1 Purpose

The UCWDC is registered in the state of Pennsylvania as a 501(c)(3) organization.

This Finance Practice provides tracking information for purchases, including those that are authorized per another finance practice as well as those that are authorized by an approved budget. This will provide the Treasurer and Financial Oversight Committee with information on expenditures that have been committed to so there are no unanticipated invoices requiring payment.

2. PRACTICE

1. All individual expenditures for items or services, or orders for items or services, from third party vendors in excess of \$500USD, whether budgeted or not, require that the purchaser to request approval from the Financial Oversight Committee prior to placing the order.
